

## **ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **BRUNEI DARUSSALAM GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP TO INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TENABLE IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM FOR THE 2016/2017 ACADEMIC SESSION**

The Government of Brunei Darussalam is offering annual scholarships under a special scholarship award scheme, for the 2016/2017 Academic Session.

Tenable in Brunei Darussalam, the aim of the scholarship awards is to provide applicants, with the opportunity to study at Universiti Brunei Darussalam [UBD], Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali [UNISSA] and Institut Teknologi Brunei [ITB].

The academic year for UBD, UNISSA and ITB commences in July / August 2016.

#### **1. ELIGIBILITY**

- 1.1 Citizens of ASEAN, OIC and Commonwealth member countries and others are eligible to apply.
- 1.2 Applicants must be between the ages of 18 - 25 for undergraduate programmes and not exceeding the age of 35 for postgraduate programmes on the 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2016.
- 1.3 The award is NOT eligible to Brunei Permanent Residents and foreigners residing in Brunei Darussalam.

#### **2. TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIP**

- 2.1 The Scholarship award is normally tenable for the minimum period required to obtain the specific degree which is four (4) years for a First Degree with Honours, one (1) to two (2) years for a Master's Degree, at UBD, UNISSA and ITB, three (3) years for a Doctoral Degree at UNISSA, three (3) years for Diploma of Health Sciences at PB (Politeknik Brunei), all on a full-time basis.
- 2.2 The Scholarship award is subject to the scholar maintaining satisfactory conduct and progress in his/her studies. This requires the scholar to maintain an active registration and academic status by passing the prescribed semester examinations and attaining the minimum course credit units. The scholarship will be reviewed at the end of each semester. Should the scholar fail to obtain the minimum course credit units or is placed on probation status, the scholarship award will be terminated and revoked.
- 2.3 The duration of the scholarship granted will NOT be extended in any case, and changes of institution or programme is not permitted.

### 3. THE BENEFITS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 3.1 The scholars are exempted from paying tuition fees and other appropriate compulsory fees as determined by the institutions for the duration of the programme.
- 3.2 One return economy class air ticket for the most economically viable route to Brunei Darussalam will be determined by the Government of Brunei Darussalam. No additional assistance will be provided towards other travel expenses.
- 3.3 Allowances payable will include:
- i) Monthly personal allowance of BND500.00;
  - ii) Annual book allowance of BND600.00;
  - iii) Monthly food allowance of BND150.00;
  - iv) Upon completion of the programme, baggage allowance to a maximum of BND250.00 to a country in the ASEAN region or BND500.00 to countries outside the ASEAN region.
  - v) The allowances and rates given are subjected to Brunei Government Policy Change during the term of the scholarship.
- 3.4 An accommodation at respective institution's residential college is provided. If the scholar opts not to live in the provided accommodation, no additional allowance will be given in lieu of board and transport.
- 3.5 OUTPATIENT medical and/or dental treatment is complimentary at any Brunei Government hospitals. However, an administrative charge is payable for each consultation with the government general practitioner or specialist.
- 3.6 Should the scholar opts to seek medical and/or dental treatment at a private hospital or clinic, all expenses are to be borne by the scholar himself/herself.
- 3.7 The scholar is **NOT** eligible to claim any other facilities apart from those aforementioned under item 3.

## 5. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 5.1 Scholars are not encouraged to bring their family members for the duration of the scholarship.
- 5.2 Spouse and/or child allowance is not payable to the scholar. Accommodation is not provided to an accompanying family member or any other person.
- 5.3 This scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other scholarship, fellowship, grant or loan without the prior approval of the Government of Brunei Darussalam. This scholarship will be terminated immediately should the scholar be found to concurrently hold another scholarship.
- 5.4 Under no circumstances are the scholars allowed to leave the country for more than 30 days per academic year without prior permission from the Ministry of Education of Brunei Darussalam. Failure to comply with this condition may lead to the forfeiture of payments of the scholar's monthly allowance.
- 5.5 The scholar may not undertake paid employment or serve on the staff of their country's representative in Brunei Darussalam during the award.
- 5.6 The Government of Brunei Darussalam will not be responsible for securing employment for the scholar after graduation.
- 5.7 An applicant may be required to appear for an interview at such place(s) as may be determined by the institutions offering the programmes, and to sit a written examination to assess the scholar's proficiency in the English Language / Malay Language / Arabic Language (where applicable).
- 5.8 The scholar must abide by the rules and regulations of the institution of study and the laws of Brunei Darussalam.
- 5.9 The scholarship is granted for studies in Brunei Darussalam only and therefore do not include participation in any form of activities under the Study Abroad Programmes nor the Discovery Year Programmes. The scholar may however choose to participate in such programmes at his/her own expense.
- 5.10 The Government of Brunei Darussalam reserves the right to terminate the scholarship awarded to the scholar as recommended by their respective institution or if deemed to be justifiable. Those who terminated must return to their country of origin immediately.
- 5.11 Upon completion of the programme, the scholar is required to return to their country of origin with immediate effect.
- 5.12 If a scholar wishes to withdraw from the Brunei Darussalam Scholarship during the course of study, the scholar has to give one month advance notice and repay the full costs received by the scholar to the Ministry of Education of Brunei Darussalam. The scholar's return home airfare will be on their own expense.

5.13 It is a prerequisite for the scholar to insure themselves with 24 hours traveling and health insurance for the whole duration of their stay in Brunei Darussalam at their own expense.

5.14 Application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the National Focal Point for scholarships in the scholar's country.

5.15 Applicants are required to get a security clearance statement from their National Security Agency / Police Station (i.e. clear from any civil and criminal records).

## **6. TERMINATION**

6.1 Student will entitle to one way economy ticket.

6.2 Student are to leave Brunei Darussalam with immediate effect.

## **7. HEALTH**

7.1 The offer is subject to the attainment of a certificate stating that scholars are medically fit to undertake the scholarship to study in Brunei Darussalam, to be issued by a qualified medical practitioner which is registered with the local Government. All charges for the medical expenses are to be borne by the scholar.

7.2 Successful applicants need to undergo health screening in Brunei Darussalam if deemed necessary by the Government of Brunei Darussalam. In cases where the applicant does not pass the health screening, they are to return to their home country at their own expense.

## **8. VISA AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS**

8.1 The successful applicant is required to be in a possession of a passport valid for the whole duration of their study in Brunei Darussalam.

8.2 The air ticket will be arranged by the Brunei Darussalam Foreign Mission in the scholar's country of origin or the closest Brunei Darussalam Mission to that country. If the scholar purchases his/her ticket without prior authorization from the relevant Brunei authorities, the scholar forfeits his/her right to the ticket and/or reimbursement for the ticket.

8.3 The scholar's Student Visa will only be issued upon arrival in Brunei Darussalam. Entry visa for scholars from countries that have a Brunei Darussalam Foreign Mission will be arranged by the respective Missions. For others, a visa upon arrival will be arranged by the Brunei Ministry of Education.

## **THE BRUNEI DARUSSALAM GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2016/2017 ACADEMIC SESSION**

Applicants who fulfil the minimum entry requirements in a programme of their choice offered at Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (UNISSA) at either PhD programme, Master's Degree (Coursework and Dissertation) programme or Bachelor's Degree programme are now eligible to apply to UNISSA under the Brunei Darussalam Government Scholarship (BDGS) Scheme for academic year 2016/2017.

Applicants must note that fulfilling the entry requirements does not guarantee entry into UNISSA's programmes as admission to all programmes is competitive and limited.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

#### **1. Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) programme**

- 1.1 A) Applicant must have a relevant master degree from an institution recognised by the Senate of UNISSA; or
- B) Applicant who has attained a relevant bachelor degree with First Class Honours (1<sup>st</sup> Class with Honours) may be considered at the discretion of the Senate of UNISSA.
- 1.2 Applicants who have fulfilled the entry requirements and shortlisted by BDGS Working Group Committee are required to attend an interview session conducted by the University via Skype.

#### **2. Master's degree programme**

- 2.1 A) Applicant must have a bachelor degree with at least Second Class Honours (2<sup>nd</sup> Class with Honours) or 'Jayyid' in the relevant discipline; or
- B) Applicant has attained a bachelor degree in the relevant discipline

and has not less than three (3) years of working experience in the related field.

- 2.2 Applicants applying for admission to Arabic-medium master's degree programme may be required to sit for - and pass - Arabic Language test.
- 2.3 Applicants applying for admission to English-medium master's degree programme must obtain at least a credit 6 in both Mathematics and English Language subjects in Brunei-Cambridge GCE 'O' Level examination. In lieu of English Language subject, a grade C in IGCSE English or an IELTS score of 6.0 or TOEFL minimum overall score of 550.
- 2.4 Applicants who have fulfilled the entry requirements and shortlisted by BDGS Working Group Committee are required to attend an interview session conducted by the University via Skype.
- 2.5 Interested applicants for Master's Degree (Research) programme are advised to consult the relevant faculty before making a formal application.

NOTE:

Master's degree programmes by Coursework & Dissertation will only be offered if there are at least five (5) candidates registered in each of the programmes.

**3. Bachelor's degree programme**

**Arabic-medium Programmes**

- 3.1 Applicants applying for admission to Arabic-medium degree programmes must passed Sixth Form/Year 13 Religious School Examination or its equivalent with an average grade 'Jayyid' or minimum points of 160 in 2 Arabic-medium subjects or 200 in 3 Arabic-medium subjects, and the subjects must be of minimum grade 'D'.

*(Grade A = 120 points; Grade B = 100 points; Grade C = 80 points; Grade D = 60 points)*

- 3.2 Applicants with Higher National Diploma (HND) may be considered, subject to fulfilling the requirements of the relevant programme.
- 3.3 Applicants applying for admission to Arabic-medium degree programmes who have fulfilled the entry requirements and shortlisted by BDGS Working Group Committee are required to sit for - and pass - Arabic and English Language Placement tests conducted at the Consulate of Brunei Darussalam.

**English-medium Programmes**

- 3.4 Applicants applying for admission to English-medium degree programmes must:

- A) Passed Primary School Religious Examination certificate or its equivalent;
- B) Obtained at least credit 6 in Mathematics subject at Brunei-Cambridge General Certificate of Education (GCE) 'O' Level or its equivalent;
- C) Obtained at least credit 6 in English Language subject at Brunei - Cambridge GCE 'O' Level or a grade C in IGCSE English or an IELTS score of 6.0 or TOEFL minimum overall score of 550;
- D) Passed GCE 'A' Level or its equivalent with at least minimum points of 160 in 2 subjects or 200 in 3 subjects, and the subjects should be of minimum grade 'D'; or passed International Baccalaureate (IB) Examination with a minimum score of 28 points.

*(Grade A = 120 points; Grade B = 100 points; Grade C = 80 points; Grade D = 60 points)*

- 3.5 Applicants applying for admission to English-medium degree programmes who have fulfilled the entry requirements and shortlisted by BDGS Working Group Committee are required to sit for - and pass - English and Arabic Language Placement tests conducted at the Consulate of Brunei Darussalam.
